

Going Forward Action Plan

1. Communications Team

Purpose: to communicate what we believe and protest error

- Develop belief statement communiqués that effectively detail what Hebron Church believes and stands for
- Utilize various forms of electronic and print media to communicate our beliefs
- Internal communications – bulletin inserts, *Hebron Herald*, web, etc.

2. Church Relations Team

Purpose: to establish a team to interface with like-minded churches

- Initiate contact with local like-minded leaders to act in one accord
- Join the “conservative covenant group” in Pittsburgh Presbytery
- Explore joint worship, conference, and seminar sponsorship with local conservative congregations
- Establish communication links with other denominations that share our commitment to Christ and our vision for ministry
- Monitor New Wineskins, Presbyterians for Renewal, etc.

3. Denominational Monitoring Team

Purpose: to become active and involved in the PCUSA

- Nominate elders for Presbytery Committees
- Send representative(s) to GA
- Advise Session on actions taken by others, e.g. overtures, etc.
- Author/Co-author overtures to Presbytery
 - a. e.g. Round Hills’ overture regarding graceful separation policy

4. Prayer Team

Purpose: to mobilize the congregation in prayer

- Develop a church wide prayer program
- Engage the congregation in proactive prayer for all of the efforts underway to stand for Christ within this denomination/world
- Establish corporate prayer meetings
- Communicate & coordinate specific prayer efforts in conjunction with critical denominational decisions/efforts
- Conduct periodic meetings with Sunday School classes, small groups, Bible studies, Youth Program, etc., on denominational topics of prayer.
